Day I - Tues July 15 - Depart JFK

Late night departure on Delta/Air France.

Day 2 - Wed July 16 - Arrive in Venice

After a layover in Paris, arrive in Venice in the early evening. Transfer to our hotel via boat and join for a welcome dinner. (D)

Day 3 - Thur July 17- Venice
