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Day 1 - Tues Apr 28- Depart JFK

Emirates flight departs late morning.

Day 2 - Wed Apr 29- Arrive in Cairo

After a layover in Dubai, afternoon arrival in Cairo. Transfer to our hotel where we'll enjoy dinner. (D)

Day 3 - Thur Apr 30- Cairo

Embark on a full-day tour of Egypt's most important highlights, starting with the Great Pyramids, one of the Seven Wonders of the World, and the Great Sphinx. Relax during a memorable lunch with phenomenal views of the Pyramids! After, we'll tour the Grand Egyptian Museum where we'll discover priceless antiquities and centuries old mummies. Our day will end with free time at the famous Khan el Khalili Bazaar, a sprawling souk with hand hammered copper, ceramic ware, spices, perfumes, and much more. (B, L)

Day 4 - Fri May 1- Cairo/Aswan

Board an early morning flight to Aswan. Take in the splendid water views at a scenic restaurant for breakfast before beginning our tour of Aswan which begins at the Nubian Museum. After we'll board our deluxe Nile Cruise boat for lunch, followed by a tour of Aswan's High Dam. A motorboat will bring us to Philae Temple before we return to dinner on our boat. Tonight's Entertainment on board tonight features a Nubian show. (B, L, D)

Day 5- Sat May 2- Nile Cruise

A short boat ride will bring us to a Nubian village where we'll learn about the Nubian culture lifestyle. The Nubian people are known for their vibrant colored traditional homes, enduring customs, and warm hospitality. Then our boat sets sail toward Kom Ombo, where we'll visit a double temple dedicated to the crocodile god Sobek and the falcon head god Horus. A Galabia party takes place on the Nile cruise boat this evening - those who are interested can dress up. (B, L, D)



The Grand Egyptian Museum (GEM) has been twenty years in the making. Encompassing a massive 490,000 square-meters, the Grand Egyptian Museum houses over 100,000 ancient artifacts spanning 7,000 years of Egyptian history. It will be the world's largest archaeological museum and the new home of Tutankhamen's treasures. After years of delays, it is slated to open on July 6, 2025 and Retel Tours is proud to include a visit to what is a brand new world renowned museum that will preserve Egypt's glorious past.



Day 6- Sun May 3- Nile Cruise

Sail on to Edfu, where we'll ride on a horse drawn carriage to the Temple of Edfu. Cooking class on cruise. Arrive in Luxor in the afternoon and tour Luxor's East Bank. Our final night on the cruise boat will culminate with a belly dancer & Tanoura show. (B, L, D)

Day 7- Mon May 4 - Nile Cruise/ Luxor

Day 8 - Tues May 5 - Luxor/Dubai

Day 10- Thur May 7- Dubai
